



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

 - Is the Year End Report due before the current year's application?
 No. The Year End Report for funds received last December is not due until September 1.
 - 2. What is considered to be the "Tri-State Area?

The Tri-State Area is considered to be Ohio/Indiana/Kentucky within the Greater Cincinnati area and the programs must benefit the residents of Tri-State Area.

- **3.** How much should I ask for when filling out the application? There are no amount requirements, however, average requests range from \$25,000 to \$75,000.
- 4. Can an organization apply if they received funds last year?

Yes. Organizations may apply as long as an Acknowledgement Letter for the funds received last year was provided by the deadline. Any organization that fails to acknowledge funds by the deadline will be prohibited from submitting a grant request for a period of not less than five years.

5. Can the application deadline be extended?

No. The deadline to submit a grant request is August 1 of each year and there are no exceptions.

6. When will I be notified if my application was approved or denied?

Applicants will be notified no later than December 31.
